Tim Curry to step down as President of the Atlantica Centre for Energy

Saint John: Chairperson Stephen MacMackin announced today that Tim Curry will be stepping down as President of the Atlantica Centre for Energy due to health reasons.

“It is with regret that the Board of Directors has accepted Tim’s resignation. Tim has served the Centre and his community with distinction over the past number of years as President of the Centre. He has been a constant and constructive voice for encouraging responsible growth in the region’s energy sector.” stated MacMackin.

Mr. MacMackin said that the Centre’s Vice-President John Herron will now serve as the Centre’s President. Mr. MacMackin added that this transition comes 5 months earlier than anticipated as Mr. Curry had planned to step down after the Centre’s Annual General meeting in late February.

Mr. Curry expressed: “I appreciate the opportunity that I have had to serve as the Centre’s President. It has been exciting to see the growth in the sector over the past several years. I had been working with John and the Board to plan for a transition in the New Year, but I have some health issues that need to be dealt with a bit sooner than that, so now seemed an appropriate time to make the move. Having worked closely with John for the past three years, I had no hesitation in recommending him to the board as a most appropriate choice, and I wish him and the Centre every success.”

Mr. Curry will remain a member of the Board of Directors and is expected to resume this role in the Spring of 2011.
